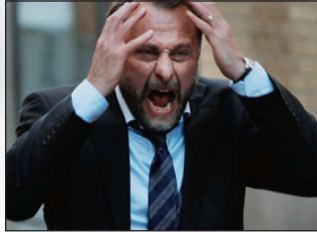

Johan Brisinger was born in 1965 and raised in Stockholm. Graduated from the School of Cinema-Television at the University of Southern California in Los Angeles, Johan became a well-known award-winning director of music videos and TV commercials. He wrote and directed the short film *Passing Hearts* (2004), which won multiple awards on the international film festival circuit, and is one of Sweden's most award-winning short films of the past decade. Johan made his first feature film in 2006 with *Suddenly* and won the Audience Award at the Guldbagge Awards in 2007.
